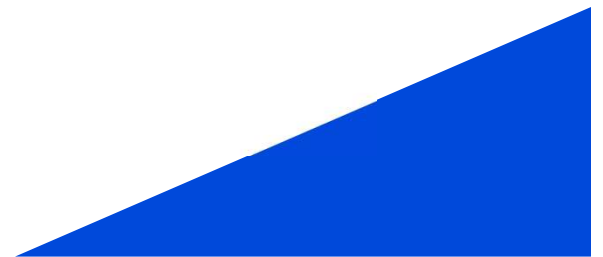
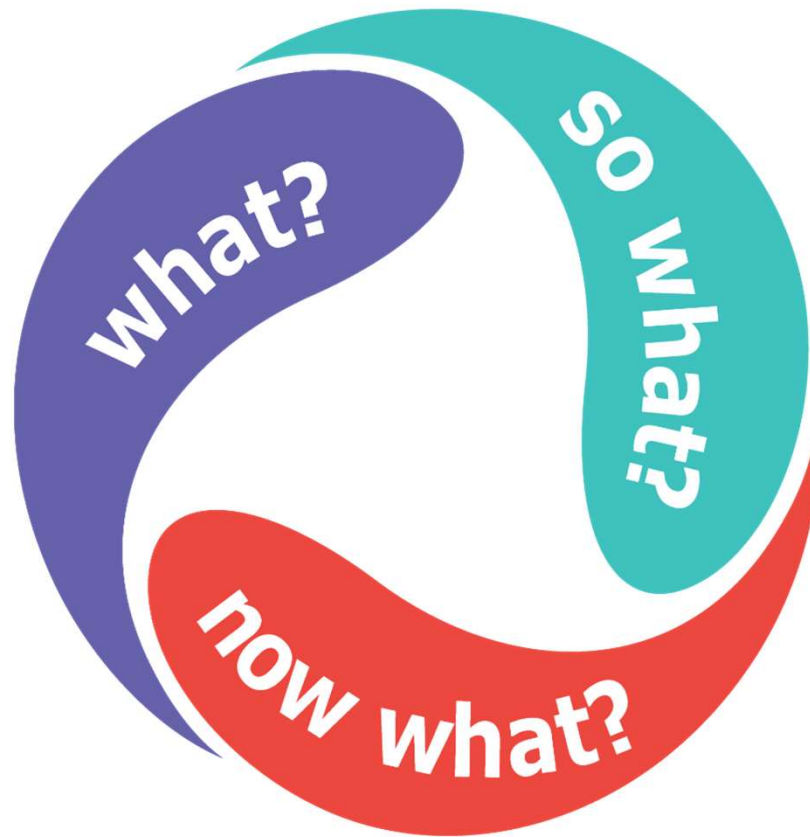
What is Adaptive Action, and why should you care?

Three-step process to collect, analyze, and take action on wicked problems in VUCA (volatile, uncertain, complex, ambiguous) environments.

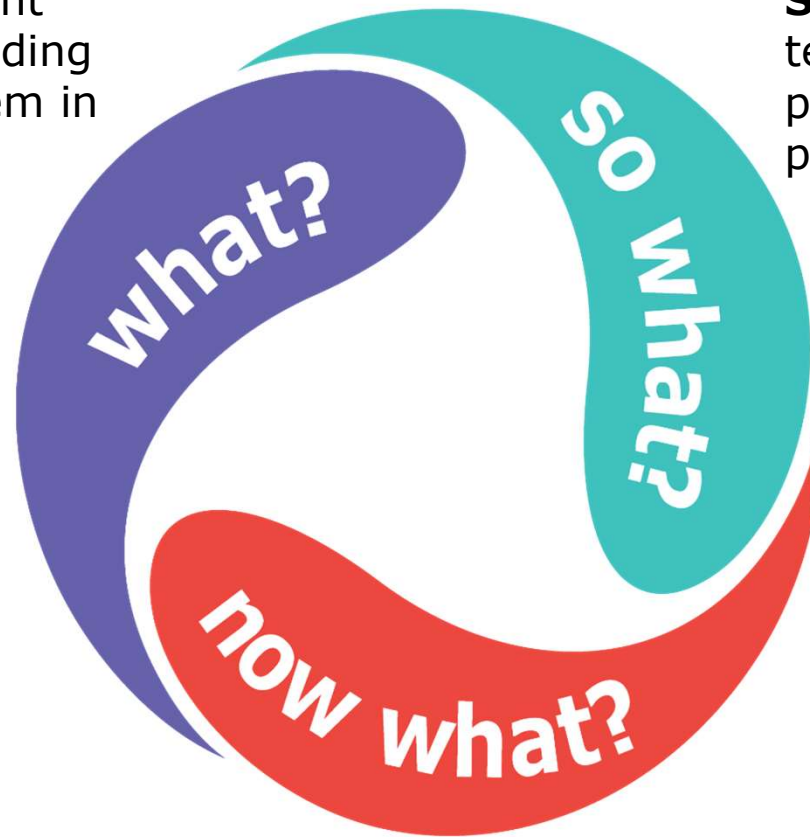




Adaptive Action Is . . .

What is the current pattern that is holding this wicked problem in place?

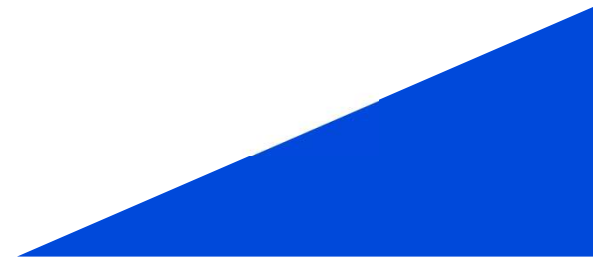
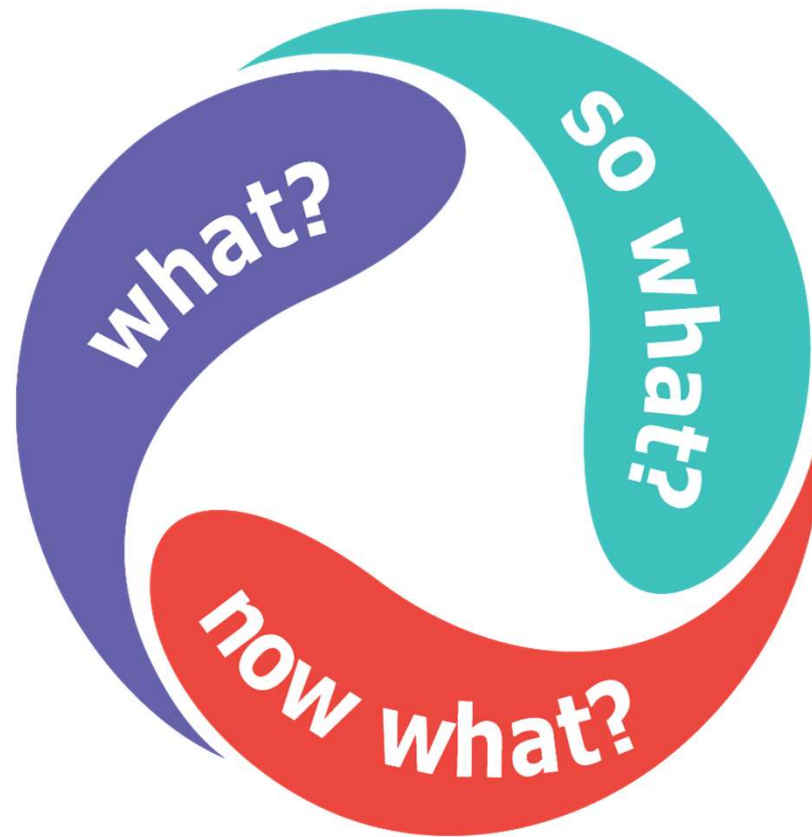
So what are the tensions that hold potential to shift the pattern?

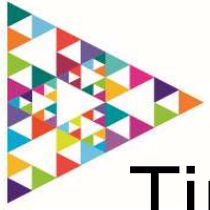


Now what can you do to release the tension and change the pattern?
